Thomson Reuters Canada is now the exclusive publisher of Federated Press tax publications and recorded continuing professional development (CPD) programming.

Thomson Reuters Canada is publishing archival and future issues of the Corporate Tax Planning and Personal Tax Planning journal series in a new area of Taxnet Pro called Federated Press Centre. In the short term, Thomson Reuters Canada will publish *Taxation of Corporate Reorganizations* in print loose-leaf format only while we set plans for a digital version. At this time we do not intend to host in-person CPD conferences; however we are considering alternative approaches to CPD, including web seminars.
